- 6. Answer the following questions <u>in your lab report</u>, as well as <u>describing the</u> <u>process</u> of going through the preceding steps:
 - a. Which questions did you complete successfully? Which Linux CLI topics did you understand the most fully? (*Question numbers alone are not sufficient!*)
 - b. Which questions did you struggle with the most? What topics did you find the most difficult? (*Question numbers alone are not sufficient!*)
 - c. Were there any questions you were unable to answer, at all? Why?
 - d. Where do you need to improve the most in your CLI abilities?
 - e. How you plan on achieving this improvement? Please be <u>specific</u> about any steps you plan to take -- and any resources you plan to use -- for improving in these areas.
