

How to access fantasyland.cs.umb.edu from your home computer

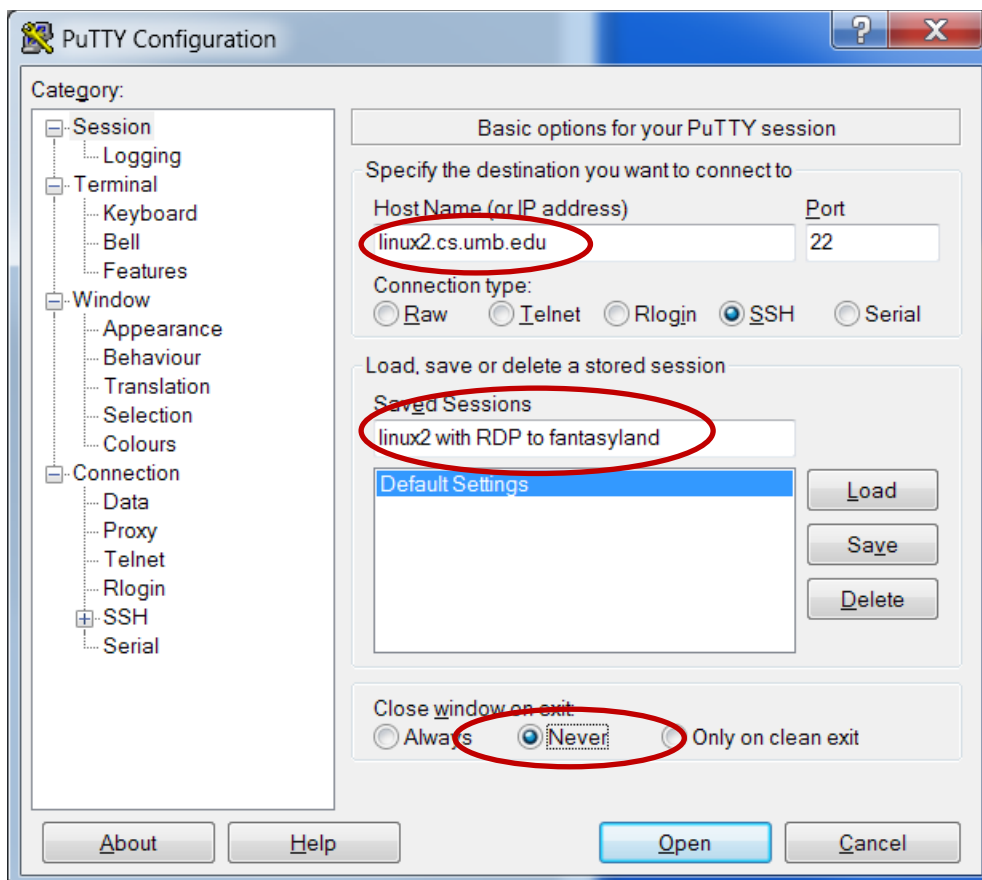

Note: You should connect to fantasyland.cs.umb.edu directly using Remote Desktop Access if you are at the UMass Boston campus.

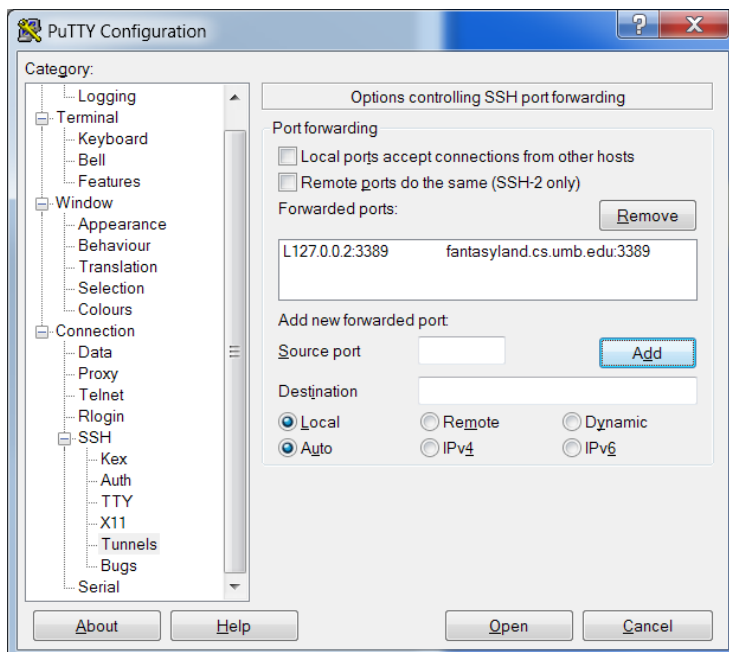
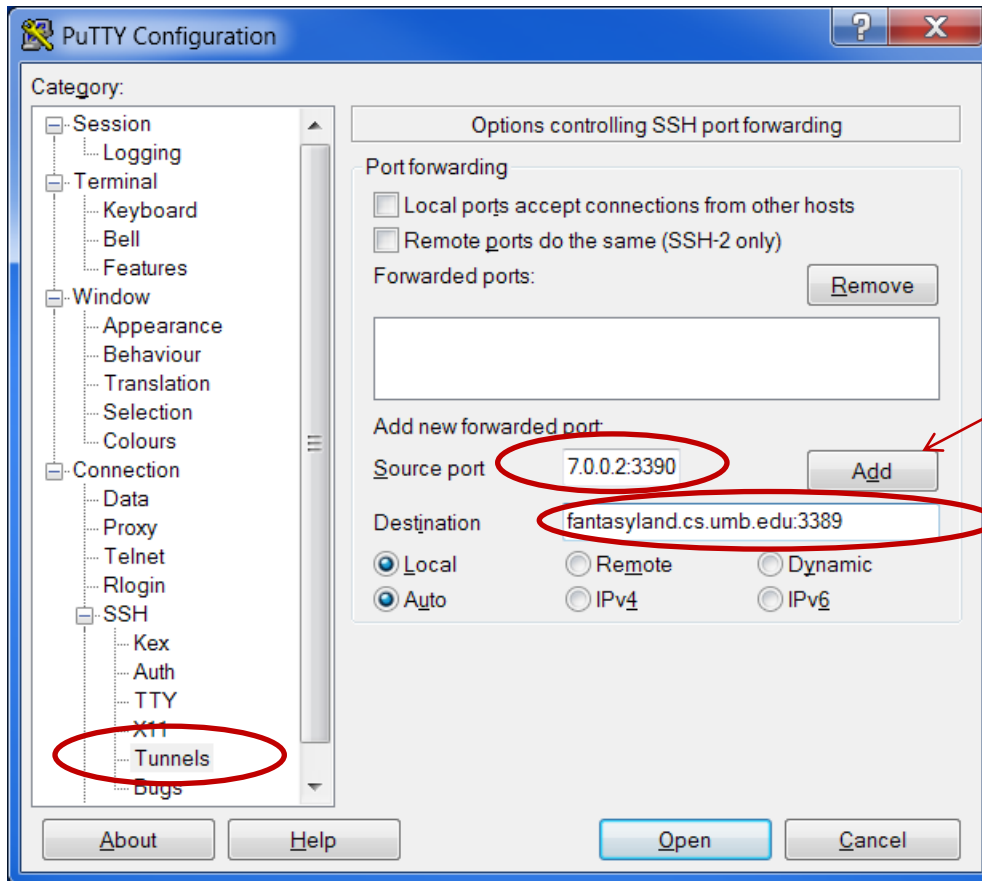
If you are outside the network of UMass Boston, we will tunnel Remote Desktop Protocol (RDP) through the putty ssh client.

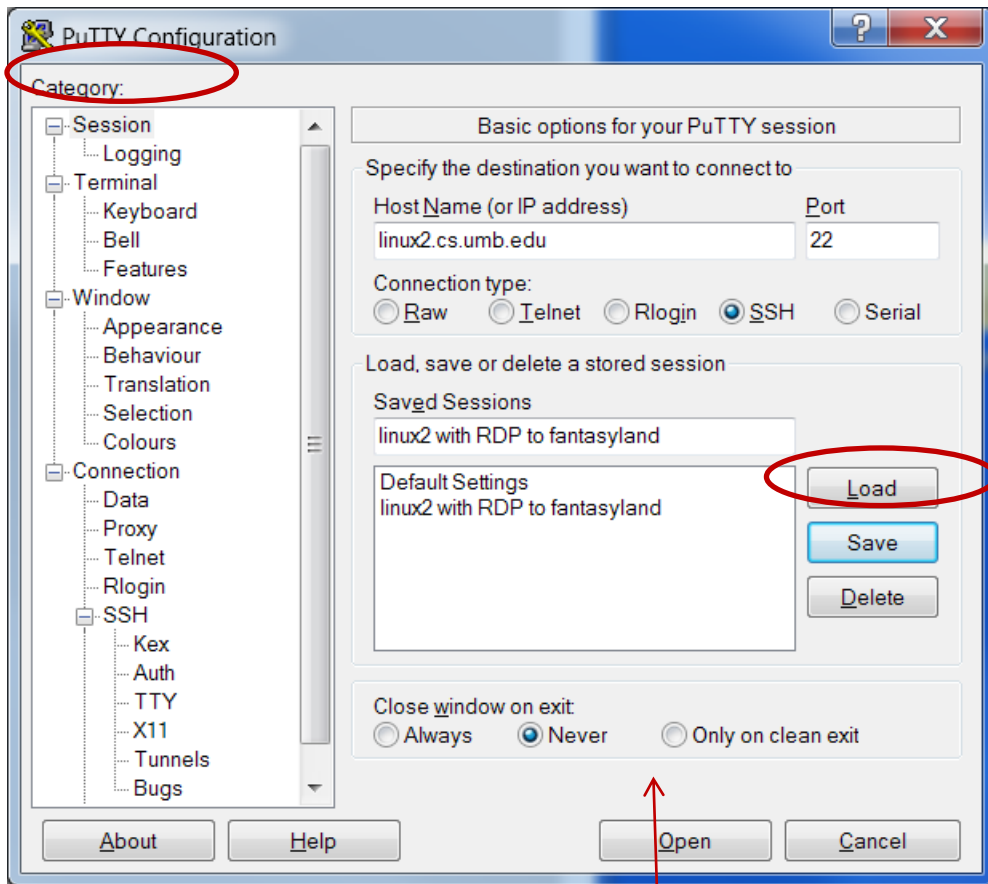
1. STEP 1: Run Putty (search for the keyword, download and install the software)



2. STEP 2: enter 127.0.0.2:3390 in “Source port”




3. STEP 3: Click Session--Logging



Click Open AFTER you save the configuration

4. STEP 4: log into linux2.cs.umb.edu using your class account and password
