

Slide 2: The Problem (The "Why")

- Visual: Images of cluttered bulletin boards or a "ghost town" campus quad.
- Key Points:
 - Students miss important events because info is scattered (email, flyers, social media).
 - Lack of a centralized, real-time "Source of Truth."
 - Low engagement with faculty achievements and program updates.

DIGITAL COMPLEXITY

 - All-in-One Dashboard: A unified view of time, weather, and schedules.
 - Dynamic Announcements: Highlighting faculty awards and program news.
 - Live Ticker: Scrollable bar for urgent job postings or news (like the "Open Position" bar in your image).

INEFFICIENT OPERATIONS

Visual: Icon-based list.

1. Event Calendar: Grouped by date and time (Friday, Oct 2, etc.).
2. Multimodal Integration: Support for Zoom links, physical locations, and streaming URLs.
3. Real-Time Data: Weather API integration and clock synchronization.
4. Admin Portal: Easy backend for staff to upload "Congratulations" slides or event flyers.
