Choose ONE research paper of your choice with the following criteria:
 - a) Must be published after 2005 (including 2005)
 - b) The main topic in the paper must be related with artificial intelligence (please consult with the Instructor if you are not sure)

 - b) Paper name
 - c) Author names
 - d) The PDF file of the paper
